It's hard to believe that March 1st completes my second year anniversary here at Salem. So much has happened in the last two years at Salem. And I'm excited to see what my third year here at Salem holds.

#### LION OF JUDAH / TANZANIA MISSION TRIP

Dear Salem Church Family - As many of you already know, I will be traveling to Lion of Judah in Tanzania for a mission trip. After much prayer, and conversations with Jim Ressler and Janelle Rhodes Luray, who have previously gone to Lion of Judah, God is sending me outside of my comfort zone. He has been guiding me down this pathway, at times pushing and sometimes hitting me over the head, to use the talents and abilities that he has blessed me with in a new direction of ministry. I'm excited and a bit nervous for the cultural differences, but know God is, and will be, with me on this journey and new adventure.

According to Hart Inlow, Mtebe has said the greatest need at the school is funds for FOOD. Food prices have skyrocketed, due to six growing seasons of drought, followed by a season of excessive rain. The rains caused Lake Victoria to flood which destroyed Lion of Judah's own garden and fruit trees. Complicating and resulting in an even greater food shortage, is when Tanzania suffered previous crop failures, they purchased food from the Ukraine. Obviously, that can't happen with the massive destruction of the Ukraine by Russia.

Folks, we are talking about diet mainstays of corn, beans and rice. Fruit and meat, usually beef or chicken, were occasionally available but are now almost cost prohibitive, because the funds must go towards purchasing the dietary foundations. Not to mention that it is difficult to raise beef, when the grazing lands have withered away or Yaks for milk.

Lion of Judah is determined to continue three meals a day for their students, whereas some places are cutting back to two meals per day. There are almost 800 students at the school so you're looking at almost 2400 meals per day or 72,000 a month!!

PLEASE, prayerfully consider donating to the Lion of Judah Food Fund. All donations must be marked for the FOOD FUND. Until crops can be grown to maturity, extra donations will be necessary to feed the school students. Their parents are pastors working in harsh and poverty laden areas trying to preach the Gospel good news. Spiritual darkness is prevalent in Tanzania. Others students are orphaned or live close to the school. Lion of Judah appreciates your generosity. May God's peace and love bless each of you for we serve an amazing God. Sherry Hill
