Word of the Day: Greg

I know. Greg is a name, not a word. Oh well! You will have to get over it because I'm not changing it.

Greg is a man that I met when I became the pastor of the church I minister at. Almost immediately following my coming to the church, Greg informed me that he was terminally ill and probably wouldn't live too much longer. The Lord allowed me to minister to Greg for just over 18 months before Greg went to be with Jesus. Greg passed just a few days before I left for my Annual Training, and we will be having his Celebration of Life service the Monday I return home. There are few things I grew to admire about Greg.


First, Greg was humble. At least he was humble in the time that I knew him. Greg was a man with great influence. He was a sought after speaker, a regular on national news media talk shows, an author of articles and blogposts for well-known political organizations. Greg was also a lobbyist in Washington DC lobbying for healthcare reform. Here's the thing: I didn't know any this about him until his wife told me right before his death. He never bragged about it! He maintained a sense of humility!

Second, Greg was very giving and compassionate! Even when he could barely walk and was in immense pain, Greg organized a Bible drive where our church sent over a thousand dollars worth of shipping to an evangelist in Kenya. Greg lobbied

that our church support this man with some of our missions funds. When my 11 year old daughter accompanied me on a visit to see Greg just a couple weeks before he passed, he mustered up the strength to shuffle over to a pile of stuff, and he found a gift for my daughter.

Third, Greg was prepared. Greg was given a gift of time to prepare for his death. Personally, he sent me a letter to affirm me in my ministry efforts at Salem. This was special to me. He also made arrangements to meet with all his children and many of his dear friends. I especially admire that he took special effort to make sure all the funeral arrangements were handled so that his wife would have less to care for after his passing.

Greg knew I enjoy smoking cigars so he gave me several packs of cigarillos which I brought with me to my Annual Training and then dispersed to many of my Soldiers. I made sure to tell the Soldiers they were from Greg so we enjoyed them together in his honor.

May you learn to be like Greg. May you learn humility. May you be generous. And may you be prepared to meet your Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. I will meet Greg again one in heaven. Will you be there too?


