Pastor's Update:

Happy New Year, Salem family!

I love the start of new things. Can any of you relate? A new year! A new job (though a little nerve-wrecking)! A new car! A new house! Trying out a new restaurant! Seeing a new movie! New is fun! But more often than not, the new wears off. For the longest time, I did what everyone else did at the beginning of a new year. I made New Year's Resolutions. The problem is that I rarely kept or fulfilled my resolutions for an entire year, and then I would feel like a failure. A few years ago I was introduced to a new concept. Instead of making resolutions, I take the last few months of the year asking God to give me one word that will guide me through the next year.

My one word for 2022 was "GROW." I wanted to grow in grace, grow in responsibility, grow in obedience, and grow in wisdom. And though there's always room for more growth, I believe that I did grow in all those areas.

My one word for 2023 is "Confidence." God gave me this word earlier than I have ever received my word. He gave it to me at the EA Convocation. I challenge you, Salem, take the "one word challenge" with me. Ask God to give you one word that will guide you throughout the next year, and when he does, I encourage you to share it with me and with others so that we can make the journey with you this next year.
