MEET JONATHAN & GARIMA RIDER -

Jonathan and Garima have been serving in India as missionaries among unreached Hindus for more than 19 years. They have two daughters - Amrita (4) and Kaira (2). They are the leaders of Friends Network, a branch of *Youth with a Mission* which is focused exclusively on reaching Hindus with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. They oversee 10 church planting teams and more than 45 staff members who have been involved in planting 120+ house churches.

They also are a part of a community that lives in and manages a retreat and outreach center in the city of Varanasi. Here Hindus can meet Jesus through times of worship, prayer, and teaching, and missionaries on the field can come for refreshment and further training. They have hosted hundreds of Hindu seekers, local believers, and field workers over the last year.

The Riders also have a heart to see evangelism and discipleship materials produced in local languages. They have created evangelistic films, content, and booklets that have been used and distributed to thousands of people in India. They also initiated an online evangelism project which has presented the Gospel to thousands of Hindus through Facebook ads and websites.

They will be joining us at Salem Church on Sunday, May 1st to share about their ministry during the 10:45 AM worship service.
