Pastor's Update:

It is the perfect month to sit out in the evening with a hoody on, drinking hot cocoa or decaf coffee, and enjoy a fire in the back yard.

Growing up my church always had this big fall festival in October! We had a big auction with a real auctioneer, the best sausage and biscuit sandwiches I've ever had, a pie contest, a bake sale, and lots of fun games for the whole family. That was a fun trip down memory lane; I hadn't reminisced on that in years.

When I lived in rural Maine, the local farmers that attended my church had a tradition they called bean-hole beans. They'd dig a deep hole in the ground, build a fire in the hole until it had some nice hot coals, then they'd put in big pot of their version of baked beans set it in the hole over the coals, then cover it up. Twenty-four hours later they would get the beans back out and have a feast.

October in the church means it's Reformation month. On October 31, 1517, a monk named Martin Luther nailed to the door of his church 95 things that he believed the Roman Catholic Church should change. There were two central beliefs in his theses: 1.) that the Bible is the central religious authority, and 2.) that humans may reach salvation only by their faith and not by their deeds.

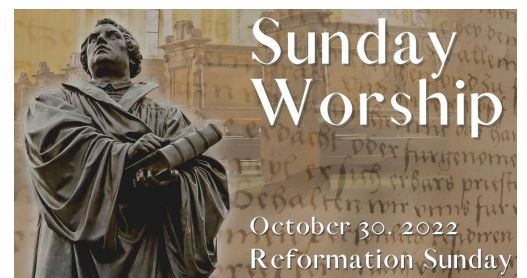

PARKING LOT UPDATE: A special Congregational Meeting was held on Sunday, August 28, 2022, at Salem Church. The meeting was called to order at 10:34 AM, by President Jean Kahl. Attendees were present in the church sanctuary and a quorum was met. The agenda item for the meeting was to gain approval from the congregation to spend up to \$12,000 to have Salem's entire parking lot and paved areas weeded, cleaned, repaired, sealed, and lined. There was a motion to proceed with the parking lot project, giving approval for spending up to \$12,000, to have the work completed. The Motion was approved with unanimous support.
