Media outlets want us to think that we are divided and the only hope for our nation is one nominee or the other. I watched the entirety of the first presidential debate, and I came away thinking that if our only hope is in one of those two individuals then we are indeed hopeless.

That is not our only hope. In fact, the political systems of this world are not the hope of the Christian in any way, shape or form. And if it is, that Christian needs to get into the Word of God and learn (or re-learn) the hope that the Gospel of Jesus Christ offers us.

With that in mind, beginning September 29, we are starting a new sermon sub-series entitled "Kingdom Priorities in Uncertain Times."
